As a Youth Director, you will be able to represent your state at national meetings in addition to informing the youth in your area of national activities. This is also the only way to be eligible to become an officer of PtHYA! To become a Youth Director, simply fill out the application found on pinto.org/youth and return it to the PtHA® office. Applications will be reviewed and applicants will be notified of acceptance. The number of Youth Directors allowed per state corresponds to the number allowed for PtHA® Board of Directors. To see how many directors are allowed in your state, check the youth page of pinto.org. In the case where more members from the same state apply than are allowed, the director will be chosen on PtHA® involvement and potential service.
