COMBINATION OF COLORS COMING TO TULSA

The Pinto Horse Association of America is proud to welcome the largest color breed horse show in the world to the Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex at Expo Square in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Colored horses from four different associations will gather for the Color Breed Congress on November 1-9, 2019.

The Color Breed Congress encompasses four separate breed shows into one. Participating breed groups include: Pinto Horse Association of America, Palomino Horse Breeders of America, American Miniature Horse Registry and Appaloosa Horse Club.

With an award budget of well over \$200,000, awards will be abundant during the show. Awards will include: Jackets from Tioga Territory for class champions and

nylon halters for Reserve Champion (with three or more shown entries), medallions for first to 10th place in each class, Gist Silversmiths' custom belt buckles, folding chairs and Kensington Protective Products for high point winners. Scholarships will be given this year to high point overall youth winners within each breed (only awarded if 20 or more units in the division). The scholarships will be redeemable upon enrollment in college.

"This year we are very excited to expand our show to now include PtHA Pleasure/Saddle type, PtHA Mini and Ponies, AMHR, WDAA and YEDA classes, as well as growing our Long Ear Congress and All Breed Ranch Congress shows with new classes and awards,"
